FORTIFY FL- APP available. FortifyFL is a suspicious activity, anonymous alerts, concerned citizen reporting tool that allows students, parents and community members to instantly relay information to appropriate school officials and law enforcement agencies about suspicious activity or harmful or potentially harmful acts against the school, students or staff.



VES will practice frequent hand washing, social distancing, in addition to daily cleaning and sanitizing the classrooms. At lunch, students will not sit directly beside or across from someone.
